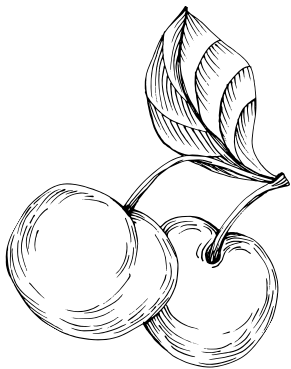


Season work in agriculture

There are many job opportunities in agriculture during growing season, especially in harvesting from mid June until August. Work demands commitment, good level of fitness and love for the outdoors.



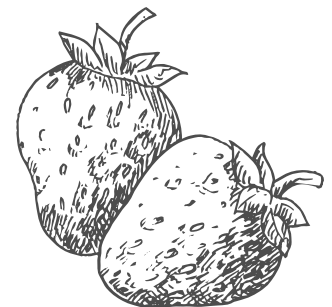
Where?

Many farms are located in remote areas. Some offer accommodation, for reasonable fee. To find out more about jobs (for free), visit: www.toitasuomesta.fi

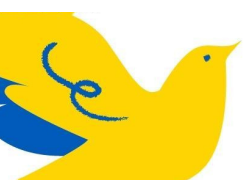
How?

The employment contract must be made in writing between you and your employer. Everyone working in Finland is subject to the same terms of employment. The minimum hourly wage in the sector for an adult is €9.00/hour and for contract pay, for example the recommendation for strawberry picking is €1.08/kg. Exceptions for orientation period, students.

Charging a fee for offering a job or arranging employment is prohibited in Finland.
